- Support your child in the completion of their homework on time and wherever possible promote opportunities for home learning.

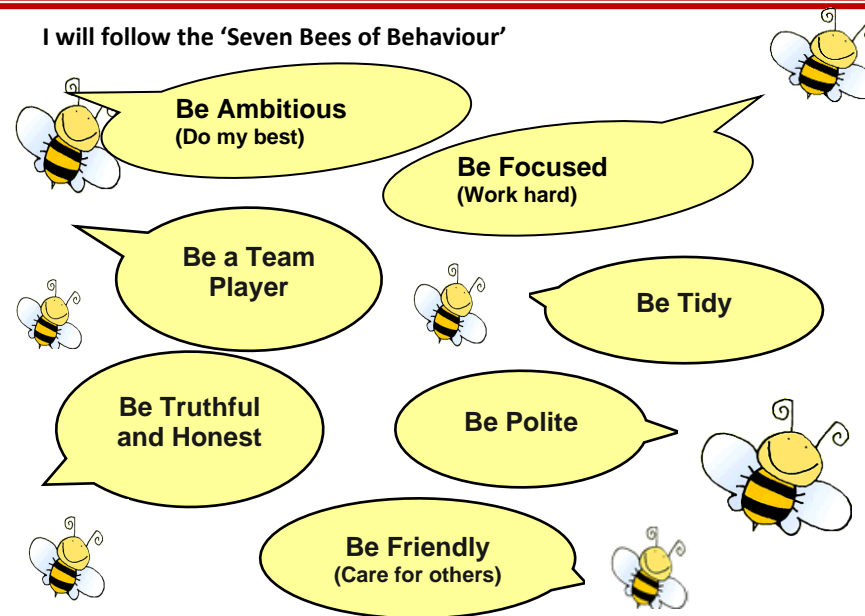
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and equal opportunities.
