Beach Trip to West Runton – Monday!

- ❖ packed lunch

- ❖ sun cream: apply before coming to school and bring the bottle with you to reapply throughout the day
- ❖ bucket and spade
- ❖ net for the rock pools
- ❖ a pair of shoes which can get wet and have a good sole – the rock pools can be slippery
- ❖ a spare pair of shoes to change into after the rock pools
- ❖ school cardigan or jumper – even though the weather could be hot, the sea breeze can be chilly
- ❖ white polo top or white PE shirt– for us to easily identify the children
- ❖ shorts/lightweight trousers
- ❖ sun hat
- ❖ waterproof coat (if rain is forecasted – please keep an eye on the weather)
