## Dear Parents,

We hope you have had a lovely week. As you can tell from the photos of children's work below, it has been another busy week for our children and once again, all the staff have been amazed and delighted by the children's creativity and enthusiasm. In school we have been very proud of the children's responsible attitude towards the new routines in place to maintain social distancing and their adherence to the other rules and restrictions relating to covid-19. Although the staff would love to see more children back from other year groups, Norfolk HSE has made it clear that staff must not teach across 'bubbles.' With limited space and staff, we have now reached capacity in most 'bubbles', providing as many places as we can. Government guidance remains that a school's priority must be on the return of children from YR, Y1 and Y6 and this means other year groups are not able to come back currently. For these children, teachers will be maintaining 'Home Learning.' However, in line with this guidance, the school is now able to open Thursday and Friday all day for the pupils already attending the mornings in Year 1.

This week we wrote to parents of the new Reception intake to welcome them to the school and give them all the information they need. This year, as the children have been unable to come into school and meet us, we made a short video that we hope will help families with the big step of starting school in September!
