More club information to follow soon.



JEWELLERY - **Please remember** that jewellery (i.e. bracelets/ necklaces etc) should NOT be worn in school – watches are acceptable.

For pierced ears, simple studs only may

be worn and must be removed for PE and/ or any afterschool sports clubs. If your child is unable to remove earrings themselves, these must be removed at home, before school. For newly pierced ears, children must tape or plaster over their earrings covering front and back (tape and plasters to be provided from home), until they can be removed. No dangly earrings should be worn, and children will be asked to remove these.
