ARRANGEMENTS FOR PARENTS AND FAMILIES—COVID-19
I want to say thank you to all our school parents and families for supporting the school so well over the first 6 weeks of this autumn term.
We are all living through a very difficult time and we have found our school families incredibly supportive of the measures we have put in place. We have used the Government compliance code to complete a comprehensive risk assessment and the arrangements we have put in place, including the staggered drop off and pick up times, wearing face masks, ensuring children from different class bubbles remain apart in the day, encouraging good hand hygiene and the other safety measures in place in the school, all help to keep our children, families and staff safe.
You may have noticed this week staff wearing masks when they are outside their class bubble and working in communal areas inside the main school building - this is to help reduce the risk of the school having to close more than one class bubble if we have a confirmed covid-19 case. Teachers are not wearing masks whilst teaching in their own class bubble or outside on the playground with their class.
The second lockdown may affect your children in different ways and at different times - if you have any concerns about their mental wellbeing please contact the school so we can support them.
