## SCHOOL WIDER REOPENING

The teaching staff have been busy re-organising each room in preparation for welcoming some of the children back to school. We thought the children would like to see some pictures of the classrooms.









School Reopening- 1 June - Please keep watching the updates from the government with regard the covid-19.

## Although we plan to reopen the school on 1 June, this date could be delayed at any stage by a change in the government's strategy.

• Reminder that we have staggered the drop off times - Y6 pupils (and siblings) 8.40AM, Y1 pupils 8.50AM (and siblings) and YR pupils 9.00AM. (*Please note, children of keyworkers can arrive at 8.30AM*). Parents arriving at the far gate can go to the orange net fencing to drop off/pick up. Staff will be waiting to meet the children. There is plenty of space for parents to keep 2 metres apart. Parents arriving at the near entrance must follow the marked path. Cones indicate 2 metre spaces. Staff will be waiting to meet the children. Parents then exit through the staff carpark.







- We want only the absolute minimal amount of belongings going between home and school.
   Younger children can bring a named water bottle and fruit snack. Sun cream must be applied before school. Year 6 children and children of key workers will need a packed lunch/water bottle.
- At midday, parents of children in Year R pick up their children. Y1 parents collect their children at 12.15PM. Y6 parents will need to collect their children at 3.10PM.
- The gates will close at 3.20PM PM. Key worker parents arriving after this time will need to go
  to the main entrance, by the office window as previously (please note school is now ending
  consistent with our usual hours when possible e.g. 3.10PM).






Evie doing class 4's weekly PE Norfolk School Games challenge - tri golf this week
