<p>Mammal</p> <p>A warm-blooded vertebrate with hair which gives birth to live young and feeds its young with its mother's milk.</p>	<p>Amphibian</p> <p>A cold-blooded vertebrate with smooth skin that can live both in and out of water.</p>	<p>Reptile</p> <p>A cold-blooded vertebrate with scaly skin which lays eggs.</p>
<p>Crustacean</p> <p>An invertebrate which has an external skeleton (shell) and lives in water.</p>	<p>Mollusc</p> <p>An invertebrate with a soft body which sometimes has a shell for protection.</p>	<p>Fish</p> <p>A cold-blooded vertebrate which has fins, gills and streamlined bodies.</p>
